V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

VI. REPORTS OF DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

A) POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The Board reviewed and approved for filing the following reports for April 2018 of Parking Summonses, Citation Activity Report, Patrol Activity Report, Statement of Accounts, Traffic Accident Report and noted an increase in Summons issued compared to last year.

The Chief shared an overview of the careers of Daniel Fetzer, Thomas Marallo and David Lingardo and stated their names have been added to the Police Memorial at the Police Awards Ceremony held on May 12th. In addition, the following Citations were presented during the ceremony:

- For his due diligence in the apprehension of a felony drug suspect Police Officer Anthony Barberan was awarded a Class "E" Citation.
- For his excellent Police work resulting in a felony weight marijuana arrest Police Officer John Park was awarded a Class "E" Citation.
- For their persistence in apprehending three suspects Detective Michael Martins and Police Officer Chris Dura were awarded a Class "E" Citation. For their assistance and excellent team work Honorable Mention Citations were awarded to John Rogliano, Ken Stevens, Paul D'Agostino, Matthew Kiernan and Jorge Lage.
- For his keen observation coupled with the rapid response of backup officers, Police Officer Alex Bonci was awarded a Class "E" Citation. For their assistance in the apprehension and recovery of stolen property Police Officers Christian Delarosa, Justin Bernstein and Sgt. Rich Rosenberg were awarded a Class "E" Citations.
- For his action in stopping a possible robbery suspect and his subsequent field investigation, resulting in the seizure of over two pounds of marijuana, Police Officer Stevens was awarded a Class "E" Citation. An Honorable Mention Citation is awarded to Paul DiPaolo.
