

RECYCLING

Place recyclables in your recycling container bin or labeled container at curbside no earlier than the night before the scheduled collection or before 7:00 a.m. on the designated collection day. Follow the recycling calendar on the reverse side. Place a weight on top of the newspapers to prevent their blowing away. In case of rain, cover the newspapers.

Rinse food and beverage containers thoroughly.

NEWSPAPER / CARDBOARD: Recycle all newspapers, including inserts, magazines, junk mail & phone books. Corrugated cardboard – dry and free of contaminants and flattened, may be placed curbside with newspapers.

Waxed Cardboard and Grey Cardboard are not accepted!

COMMINGLED: All PET and HDPE plastic containers, glass, and aluminum or tin food and beverage jars or containers, detergent containers, aerosol cans and clean aluminum foil. **Rinse thoroughly.** Labels and caps need not be removed.

NO PLASTIC BAGS, foam plastic materials, film plastic, vinyl, light bulbs, crystal, window glass, broken glass, ceramics, kitchenware, pesticide / herbicide bottles or any other containers containing potentially hazardous materials such as motor oil, pesticides, or chemicals.

CATHODE RAY TUBE (CRT'S): Items containing Cathode Ray Tubes to include televisions, computer monitors, laptops, etc. are considered recyclable. Therefore these items cannot be mixed with household garbage. You can arrange a Cathode Ray Tube pickup by contacting the Highway Department at 961-8540. For your convenience we also provide a drop-off container at the Highway Department located on Burnham Road. In order to prevent breakage the Town is requiring that residents apply tape, (crisscross pattern) over the screen prior to disposal.

GRASS CLIPPINGS & LEAVES: (YARD WASTE) Pickup on Wednesdays from April through October. These materials must be placed either in a container labeled “yard waste” or within biodegradable bags. Residents may obtain “yard waste” labels from the Highway Department and Town Hall at no charge.

PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT ACCEPTED. AFTER OCTOBER LEAVES AND GRASS CLIPPINGS ARE PICKED UP ON AN UNSCHEDULED BASIS AND MAY BE RAKED TO THE CURB. FOR SAFETY REASONS PLEASE DO NOT PUT THESE MATERIALS ONTO THE ROADWAY.

BRANCHES / BRUSH: Branches and brush must be placed at the curb, and tied with string only in bundles not greater than 4 feet in length, nor more than 40 pounds in weight. Branches / brush are picked up on an unscheduled basis.

ALL BRUSH AND BRANCHES MUST BE SEPARATED FROM THE GRASS AND LEAVES.

METAL: Includes the collection of metal appliances and other items. **NO** aluminum siding, paint cans, automobile parts, or scrap metal. Place at curbside **no earlier** than the night before a scheduled collection.

NON-COLLECTED MATERIALS

Tree Trunks (Logs), Stumps, Rocks, Dirt, Building Materials: Building Material includes concrete, asphalt, plaster, tile, sheetrock, wood (including wood doors), windows (including glass inserts), insulation, roofing material, etc. Disposal of these items must be arranged with a private carter or contractor.

Tires, Car Batteries, Used Motor Oil: Tires and car batteries must be disposed of through their place of purchase. Used motor oil must be disposed of at a gas station.

Chemicals: Household chemicals may be disposed through Westchester County. Please call **914-813-5425**.
